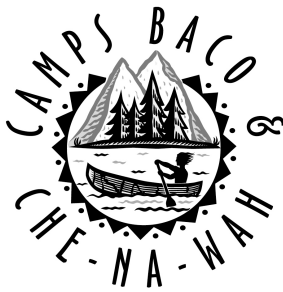

THIS ENROLLMENT IS MADE WITH THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

1. Your child must be examined by your physician and dentist and all pertinent information must be submitted to the camp office on the appropriate forms prior to the departure for camp.
2. The camper and his/her parents agree to abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in the policy of the camp for the health, safety and well-being of the camp and its campers.
3. The Directors reserve the right to send home a camper whose physical condition, conduct or influence is deemed highly unsatisfactory or inconsistent with the best interests of the camp.
4. No reduction or allowance is made for the late arrival or early withdrawal of the camper.
5. The Directors reserve the right to have the camper hospitalized, or to use outside medical, surgical or dental aid in the event of an emergency when the parent cannot be contacted. All such expenses shall be paid by the parent, if not otherwise covered by Health and Accident Insurance.
6. Camp is not responsible for the loss of clothing or personal belongings.
7. Enrollment is subject to the availability of space within the particular age group.
8. The enrollment agreement is executed upon the acknowledgment by the camp of receipt of the Application with the accompanying first payment.
9. The camp reserves the right to photograph campers and to use the pictures in advertising, promotional materials, or reports about camp.
10. Your child will be transported in camp-designated vehicles for offsite trips, to tripping drop-off points, for emergency or routine medical care.
11. The Directors reserve the right to inspect all belongings brought into the camp when the health, well-being, or safety of the camper or others requires it.
12. With this application I understand that part of the camping experience involves activities and group living arrangements and interactions that may be new to my child, and that they come with certain risks and uncertainties beyond what my child may be used to dealing with at home. I am aware of these risks, and I am assuming them on behalf of my child. I realize that no environment is risk-free, and so I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the camp's rules, and my child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them.
13. With this application, I grant permission for my Son/Daughter to participate in all camp activities, including overnight hikes, low-level raft trips, and other out-of-camp trips.
14. It is agreed that any dispute or cause of action arising between the parties, whether out of this agreement or otherwise, can only be brought in the supreme court of the State of New York located in Essex County, New York, and for any such action, the parties mutually agree to waive trial by jury and that this agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of New York.
15. Camp Baco/Che-Na-Wah must have a permit to operate from the New York State Department of Health and is required to be inspected twice yearly. Inspection Reports and required plans are filed at Saranac Lake, New York, and are available for review.
